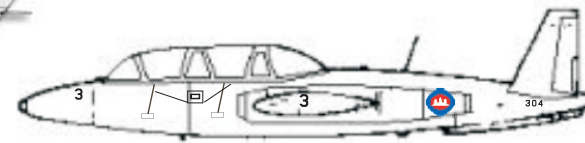
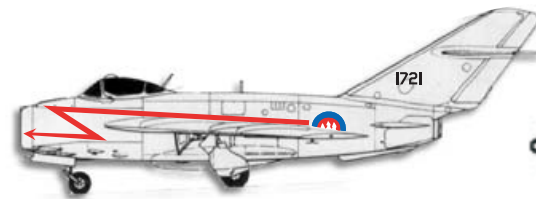
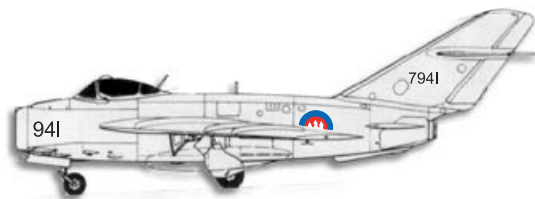
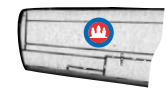
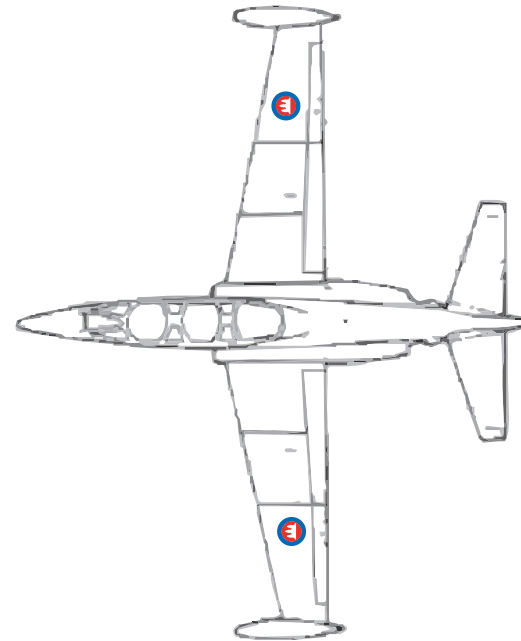
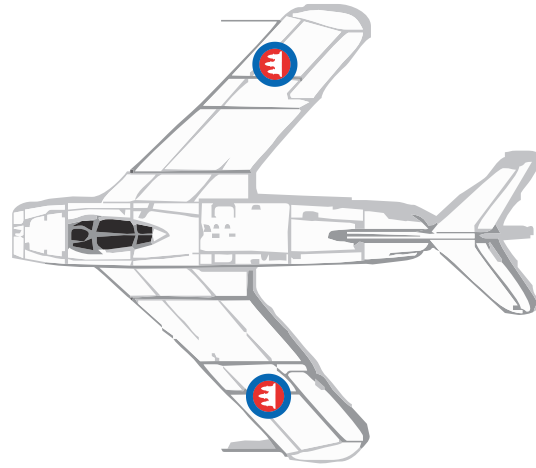
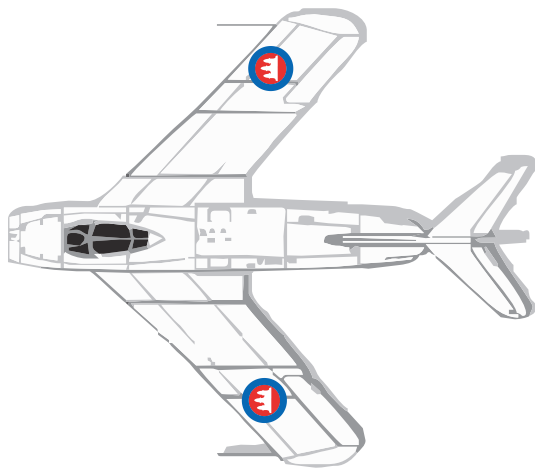




Aviation Royale Khmer (Royal Cambodian Air Force)

MiG-17, Fouga Magister and T-28 Trojan



MiG-17 'Number 7941'

This aircraft was finished in all over dull light grey. Drop tanks featured a repeat of the identification on the nose of the drop tank.

MiG-17 'Number 1721'

This aircraft was all over natural metal; this aircraft one of several Cambodian MiG-17s to carry the red lightning bolt down the fuselage side.

Fouga Magister 'Numbers 3 & 4'

The Magisters were natural metal with the identity number on the nose, tip tank and as part of a 3 digit number under the tail; '304' for aircraft number 3, and '404' for aircraft number 4. It is believed insignia on all wings, top and bottom.

T-28 Trojan

This aircraft was natural metal with the normal exhaust hiding stripe and black anti glare panel. Tail tip is believed to be red. Insignia on all wings, top and bottom.
