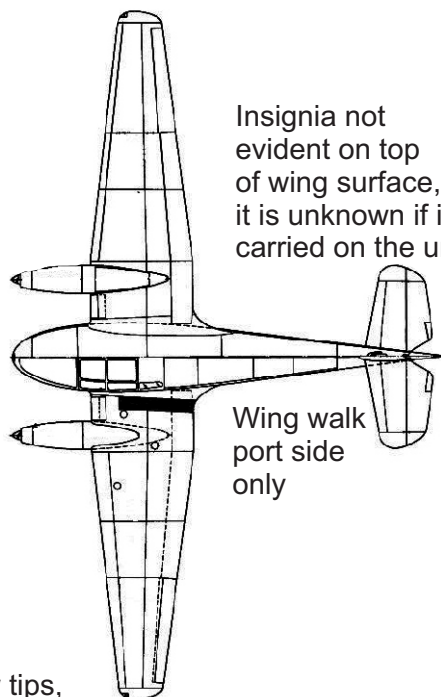
## Vietnam Peoples Air Force 1956 to 1975



This sheet is designed to provide virtually all the appropriate VPAF insignia for 1/72 scale subjects. Complete decals are provided for Aero Ae45 and T-28 Trojan. Some supplementary decals may be required for other suggested subjects. The 'suggested subjects' below are typical of aircraft flown; many other scheme options are possible.

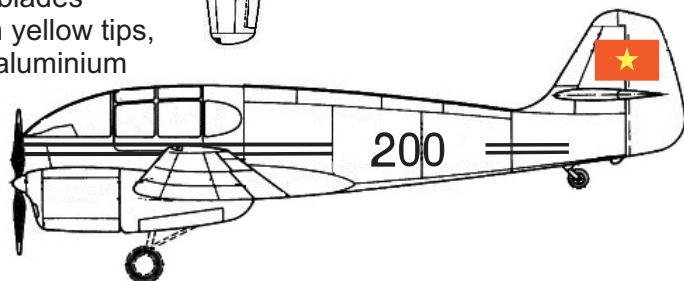
Insignia not evident on top of wing surface, it is unknown if it was carried on the underside.

Split plan view



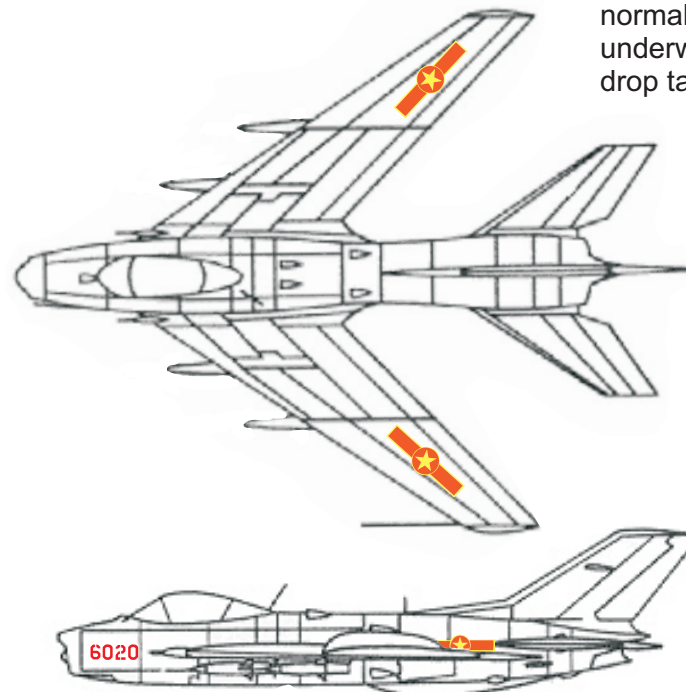
Wing walk port side only

**Aero Ae 45 Number '200'**

This aircraft was finished in all over aluminium finish. The markings and insignia included the national flag on the fin and rudder, along with the number '200' on the mid fuselage. Dual pin-stripes ran along the fuselage side, broken for the identity number. All markings are provided on the decal sheet and represent an aircraft from the late 1950's.

VPAF MiG-19s were not normally seen with underwing stores or drop tanks.

**Shenyang J-6 (MiG-19) Number '6020'**

This aircraft was natural metal with insignia on all wings and fuselage. A four digit identification number was carried on the nose. Various combinations are possible with numbers ranging from 6010 to 6069. The majority of MiG-19s were natural metal, with a limited number having a dull drab green application to their top fuselage in a limited spray pattern. Numbering is not supplied with this sheet but is generally available with Eastern Bloc air force MiG kits; alternatively, dedicated number sheets should be used.
