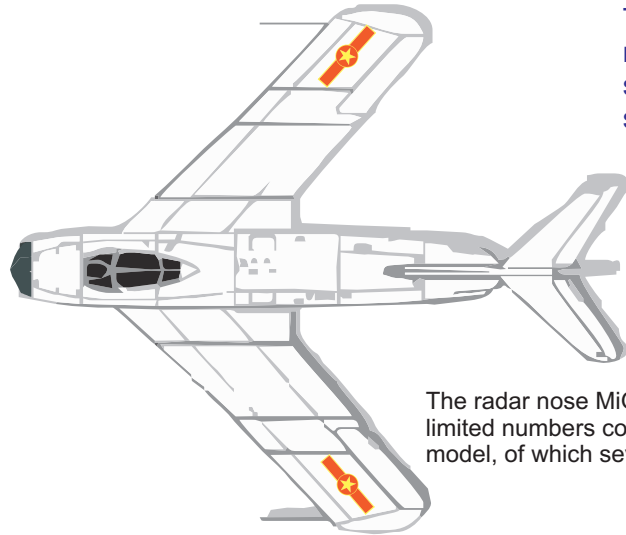

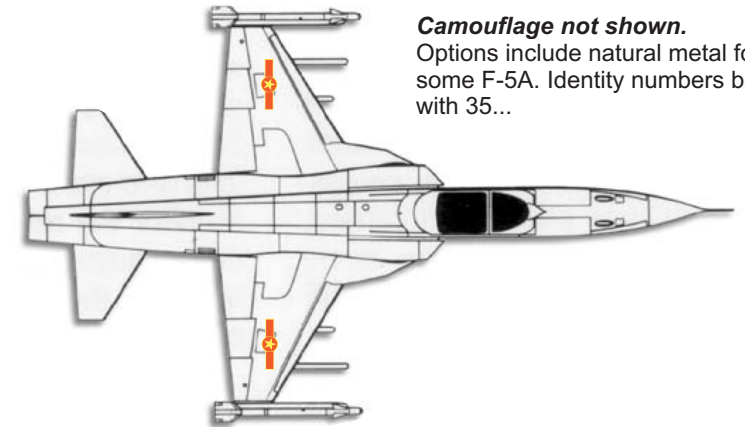

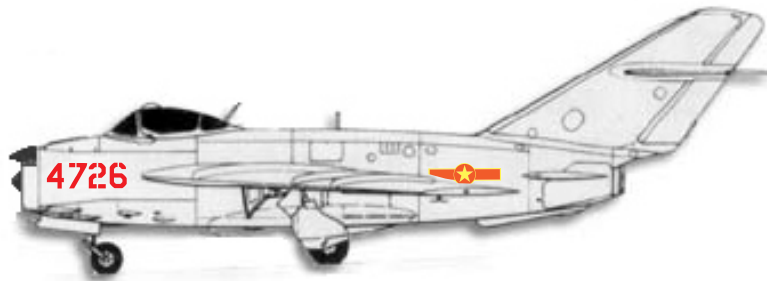
This decal sheet is designed to provide virtually all the appropriate VPAF insignia for 1/72 scale subjects. Complete decals are provided for Aero Ae45 and T-28 Trojan. Some supplementary decals may be required for other suggested subjects. The 'suggested subjects' below are typical of aircraft flown; many other scheme options are possible.



The radar nose MiG-17PF was used in limited numbers compared to the 'standard' model, of which several schemes are possible.



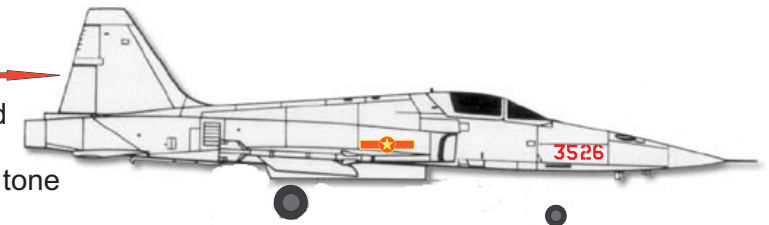

Options include natural metal for some F-5A. Identity numbers begin with 35...



MiG-17PF 'Number 4726'

This aircraft was all over light grey; with very dark grey on the aircraft radar nose fairing. This aircraft was one of several PF models. Numbering is not supplied with this sheet but is generally available with Eastern Bloc air force MiG kits, alternatively, dedicated number sheets should be used.

Original South Vietnam insignia was over-sprayed with original camouflage colour. This can be replicated by airbrushing areas on the tail fin with minor changes in tone of the standard camouflage, representing a covering over of the VNAF fin flash.



F-5A and F-5E

The aircraft maintained the original VNAF scheme after capture, most being standard USAF SEA-camouflage. All original markings were over sprayed and VPAF insignia applied. Red identity number on the nose.
